

Clinical Assignments (p. 14)

All clinical assignments must be completed by the due dates established by the faculty. Failure to complete clinical assignments may affect the student ability to meet course objectives and may result in course failure. In order to pass clinical and the course, each clinical assignment **MUST** earn an 80% or higher. Students will receive feedback from the instructor when an unsatisfactory (grade <80%) assignment is returned. If a student earns less than 80% on a clinical assignment, the student will have 3 days after receiving feedback from the faculty to re-do the assignment and resubmit for grading. The grades of the two attempts will be averaged together, and the average grade will be the recorded grade. The grade on the second attempt on an assignment must be an 80% or higher in order for the student to meet expectations of the clinical rotation.
